Steps for Demolition:

- Contact all utilities to disconnect service.
- Get an asbestos inspection This only applies if the demolition is done by a hired contractor. Private homeowners doing the demolition would be exempt per House Bill 285, the State Air Quality only regulates contractors. See www.airquality.utah.gov. But homeowners are regulated by the County, therefore, the contractor or homeowner is responsible for determining if asbestos is present.
- Get asbestos removed, if needed, by a Certified Asbestos Contractor.
- Two weeks prior to demolishing, the Department of Environmental Quality Division of Air Quality must be notified (even if no asbestos is found) (801) 536-4000 or go to www.airquality.utah.gov "ATLAS", "asbestos", "forms" and print the applicable form. There are forms for asbestos and demolition notification. If you have any questions, you may contact the State at 801-536-4000. - Before blocking any public road, you must first obtain approval from the Road Department. 435-784-3208 or UDOT 435-864-2196 to include date and times.
- In addition, before blocking any public roads, you must first obtain approval from the Sheriff's Office 435-784-3255 to include date and times.
- Material and equipment necessary for work to be done under a permit shall not be placed or stored on a public property so as to obstruct free and convenient approach by emergency vehicles or so as to interfere with the free flow of water in any ditch or canal.
- Water and sewer lines must be located and terminated before demolition.
- The continuous dampening of the demolition debris to contain dust and other contaminants from leaving the property is a major requirement.
- All hazardous conditions shall be property posted, fenced, and barricaded to protect the public
- All debris must be removed including the foundation and holes filled in by completion date and a final inspection scheduled with the Building Department.
- Basement and crawl space will be filled with off-site material.
- Fill out this application and submit, along with the copy of your approval from the Division of Air Quality, to the Planning and Zoning Department.
