

**DAGGETT COUNTY RESOLUTION 19-01**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A BUDGET ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners for Daggett County is authorized under Utah Law to adopt a plan for financial operations for a fiscal period, embodying estimates for proposed expenditures for given purposes and the means of financing the expenditures. Said plan is known as the Daggett County “budget”; and

**WHEREAS**, all taxpayers in Daggett County have an interest in the adoption of a fiscally responsible budget for the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners desires assistance in understanding the needs of the taxpayers and in receiving recommendations from concerned citizens on the adoption and makeup of the budget; and


**WHEREAS**, several citizens of Daggett County have expressed a desire to assist the County Commission and make recommendations with regard to the County budget,

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the County Legislative Body of Daggett County as follows:

1. There shall be created a “Budget Advisory Committee.” The purpose of the committee shall be to review the budget and make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners on ways to make better or more efficient use of taxpayer dollars.
2. The committee shall consist of 5 members, appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, upon application. All 5 members shall be residents of Daggett County. At least 1 member shall be a resident of the Town of Manila. At least 1 member shall be a resident of the Town of Dutch John.
3. The committee shall prepare and propose bylaws governing the function of the committee to the Board of County Commissioners for approval.
4. The Board of County Commissioners shall in no way be bound by the recommendations of the committee.


