Greetings,

Beginning on April 4th, 2019, the hourly release pattern for Flaming Gorge Dam will change according to the attached schedule. Daily average releases from the dam will likely remain at 950 cfs through at least the month of April. The change from 800 cfs was due to an operational rough zone in the turbine/generators based on the release and reservoir head.
