

Resolution 19-08

A RESOLUTION AMENDING DUTCH JOHN UTILITY WATER AND SEWER RATES AND POLICIES

WHEREAS, Daggett County established certain rates for water and sewer hookups in the Dutch John Area on March 6, 2001; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2015 the Daggett County Commission passed and adopted Resolution 15-16, a resolution amending Dutch John water and sewer rates; and

WHEREAS, review of these rates reflect a shortage of revenue to cover expenses as well as a need for an amount for contingency; and

WHEREAS, the current rates need to be adjusted in order ensure a viable system moving forward and to cover the cost of necessary repairs to the current system, including replacement of water tanks; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the County Commission to provide a sufficient fund for capital improvements and a contingency in the event of emergency. The County Commission means to provide for collection of these expenses such that the collection of total revenues equals a rate of no more than 1.5 times the actual operating expenses for a given calendar year. The County Commission intends to adjust future rates as necessary to ensure an appropriate amount is set aside for capital improvements as well as a contingency fund.

WHEREAS, the policies regarding payment of rates, late fees, reconnection fees, shut-off notices in the event of failure to timely pay, etc., which were established previously are not changed or addressed herein.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Daggett County, that the following monthly rates and policies be established for the users of the Daggett County - Dutch John Water and Sewer Systems:

Residential (1" Meter or smaller)
Base-Tier 1(0-12K gallons) \$82.00
Tier 2: (12-24K gallons) \$1.50/1,000

Tier 3: (24-36K gallons) \$2.50/1,000
Tier 4: (36K+ gallons) \$5.50/1,000

*All users located in a residential zone with a meter size of 1" or smaller shall be charged the residential rate.

Tier 2: (24-48K gallons) \$1.50/1,000
Tier 3: (48-72K gallons) \$2.50/1,000
Tier 4: (72K+ gallons) \$5.50/1,000

Medium Commercial (1 1/2" Meter)
Base-Tier 1(0-36K gallons) \$328.00
Tier 2: (36-72K gallons) \$1.50/1,000
Tier 3: (72-108K gallons) \$2.50/1,000
Tier 4: (108K+ gallons) \$5.50/1,000

Medium Commercial
Base: \$160.00


Large Commercial (2" or larger Meter)
Base-Tier 1(0-54K gallons) \$656.00
Tier 2: (54-108K gallons) \$1.50/1,000
Tier 3: (108-162K gallons) \$2.50/1,000
Tier 4: (162K+ gallons) \$5.50/1,000

Large Commercial
Base: \$320.00


Effective Date: this Resolution shall become effective upon the first day of the next billing cycle following signature of the Chair of the Daggett County Board of Commissioners.
