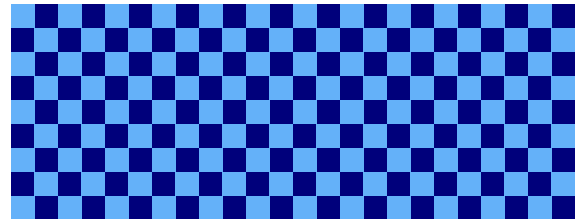

An alcohol-impaired driver crash occurred every 3 hours.

Drivers aged 21 to 24 had the highest rates of alcohol-impaired crashes.

This year, preliminary data is showing 61% of deaths from fatal crashes have occurred in rural areas.

Three From Manila High School Attend Close Up Washington, DC Event June 13-18th, 2010

Two students; Jenessa Gosar and Jaris Baker, and one teacher, Miss Jessica Christensen from Manila High School, recently took part in the Close Up Washington, DC trip June 13-18th. Forty-four high school students and six adult chaperones from across the state of Utah participated in the all expense paid trip earlier this month. The students were chosen earlier in the year, by writing an essay that described their interest in American History and how they had benefited from it.

The group of forty-four Utah High School students in the history education program were able to see firsthand our government at work and visit historical sites. Some of these sites included: Washington D.C. White House, Smithsonian National Museum of Natural History, WW II, Korean and Vietnam Memorial sites, Arlington National Cemetery, Jefferson Memorial, Franklin D. Roosevelt Memorial, Capitol Hill Reflecting Pool, Smithsonian National Air & Space Museum, U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum, Embassy Visit, Pentagon City Mall, U.S. Marine Corps, Air Force & Pentagon, 9/11 Memorial, Capitol Hill & meeting with Rep. Matheson, Senator Bennett & Senator Hatch, Colonial Williamsburg, Newseum, Smithsonian National American History Museum and many more.

The Close Up Washington, DC (Utah Group) is sponsored by the Utah Fast Pass. The late Larry H. Miller was the inspiring founder of the Utah Fast Pass, which is a non-profit organization. Aerial Mosquito Spraying Scheduled for THURSDAY MORNING, EVENING, AND POSSIBLY FRIDAY MORNING

The Daggett County Mosquito Abatement District announces plans to schedule aerial mosquito spraying for Thursday July 1st **weather and winds permitting.**

Spraying are scheduled to take place from 6:00 am to 8:00 am and 8:00 pm until dark

Although mosquito control pesticides pose low risks, some people may prefer to avoid or further minimize exposure. While not required, steps to help further reduce possible exposure to pesticides include:

- Remain indoors during applications in the immediate area.
- People who suffer from chemical sensitivities or feel spraying may aggravate a preexisting health condition, may consult their physician or local health department and take special measures to avoid exposure.
- Close windows and turn off window-unit air conditioners when spraying is taking place in the immediate area.
- If anyone feels they may be experiencing adverse reaction due to pesticide exposure, they should contact the **Utah Poison Control Center hotline at (800) 222-1222.**

Mosquito Manager Trainee

Qualifications & Requirements:

- ✦ At least 18 years of age.
- ✦ Current Drivers License with good driving record.
- ✦ Must be able to pass a criminal background check.
- ✦ Ability to walk long distances and navigate rough terrain
- ✦ Ability to follow directions
- ✦ Ability to work independently
- ✦ Ability to lift 50 lbs.

Duties will include (but not limited to):

- ✦ Pass tests to become a certified Pesticide Applicator for mosquitoes
- ✦ Drive ATV or truck to locations needing pest treatments or to collect mosquito samples
- ✦ Deploy and retrieve Mosquito traps.
- ✦ Document results of trapping activities and send samples to State of Utah.
- ✦ Follow up on resident complaints and inspect their areas for larvae and mosquitoes
- ✦ Apply larvicide or adulticide as needed to prevent build up of adult mosquitoes
- ✦ Document all activities and complete all assigned paperwork
- ✦ Attend UMAA meetings as possible and become educated on best practices for mosquito abatement
- ✦ Attend Mosquito Abatement District Board meetings and report on activities and needs.
- ✦ Learn how to train new mosquito district workers.
- ✦ Schedule and work with aerial sprayers to ensure successful applications.
- ✦ Perform all other duties as assigned.

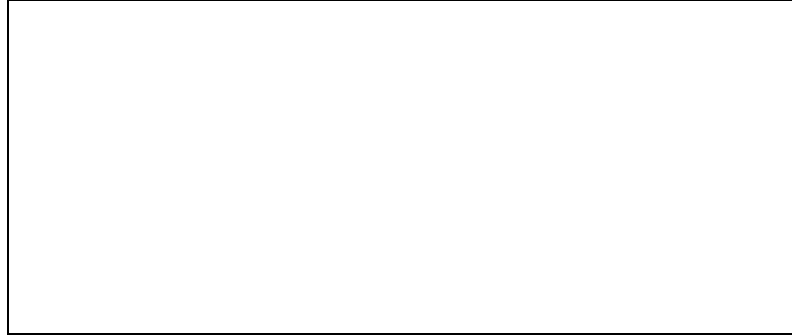
