Whereas, Condemnation Resolution No. 99-07 regarding acquisition and occupation of property known as Parcel 202 was adopted by the Board of Daggett County Commissioners on April 14, 1999; and

Whereas, the Board of Daggett County Commissioners desires to reaffirm Resolution No. 99-07 with corrections as to certain factual matters, it is hereby

Resolved that the adoption of resolution No. 99-07, including correction of certain factual matters, be reaffirmed and that Resolution No. 99-07 shall be as follows:

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**RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Daggett County that it finds, determines, and declares that:

1. The public interest and necessity require the construction by Daggett County for public improvement; namely, the Daggett County Jail Septic-Drainfield, designated as County Project No. 99-01 ("Project"), for the purpose of providing a safe septic-drainfield for the Daggett County Jail.

2. The construction and use of the public improvement necessitates the acquisition and immediate occupancy of the real property, or interests in real property, hereinafter described.

3. The County Attorney of Daggett County is instructed and requested on behalf of the Commission to acquire, in the name of Daggett County, the needed real property, or interests in real property, hereinafter described, by condemnation in accordance with the provisions of the laws, statutes, and Constitution of the State of Utah relating to eminent domain and to prepare and prosecute such proceeding in the proper court having jurisdiction thereof as may be necessary for such acquisition; and to obtain an order from the court permitting Daggett County to take immediate occupancy and use of the real property, or interests in real property, needed for the construction and use of the public improvement.

4. The County Auditor is instructed on behalf of this Commission to request a warrant from the County Treasurer in a sum equal to the approved value of the real property, or interests in real property, which sum is \$ 22,900.00, payable to Agri-Briggs Corporation, for the use and benefit of the landowner and/or lienholders as hereinafter described.

5. A tender of \$22,900 to the landowners and/or lienholders shall entitle Daggett County to the issuance of an Order of Immediate Occupancy.

6. The real property, or interests in real property, which Daggett County is by this resolution authorized to acquire for said public improvement and use is situated at approximately three miles west of Manila, Parcel 202 located in Section 22, Township 3 North, Range 19 East, Salt Lake Base Meridian, State of

Utah, and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which bears S00°04'48"E 496.70' along the west section line from the west 1/4 corner of section 22, T3N, R19E, S.L.B.&M., and N89°57'54"E 957.00' parallel to the east-west 1/4 section line of said section 22, and which is the northeast corner of the Daggett County Jail property, thence N67°26'25"E 996.54', thence S00°04'48"E 406.20' parallel to the said west section line, thence S73°19'12"W 805.86', thence S00°04'48"E 147.33' parallel to the said west section line, thence S73°19'12"W 155.00' in line with the south line of the said jail property and to the southeast corner of the said Daggett County Jail property, thence N00°04'48"W 447.00' along the east property line of the Daggett County Jail and to the point of beginning contains 7.963 acres more or less. Basis of bearings is the west section line of the SW 1/4 of said section 22 which is assumed to bear S00°04'48"E. Also a 30' easement along an existing dirt road for a right of way for ingress-egress. The centerline of the 30' easement begins at a point on the north right of way line of Utah State Highway #43 which bears S25°16'56"E 1311.57' from the west 1/4 corner of section 22, T3N, R19E, S.L.B.&M. Thence the following 17 calls: N28°04'36"E 54.48'; N08°52'53"E 134.95'; N23°27'22"E 42.50'; N56°50'33"E 32.06'; N81°32'57"E 73.28'; N64°36'40"E 95.18'; N31°34'30"E 111.55'; N21°58'37"E 83.15'; N30°41'21"E 108.73'; N43°02'14"E 102.96'; N63°19'04"E 128.78'; N53°53'18"E 75.19'; N68°10'33"E 75.15'; N81°02'22"E 31.98' to a point on the east property line of the 7.963 acres Agri-Briggs Corp. Parcel, which also bears S60°01'22"E 1907.12' from the west 1/4 corner of section 22, T3N, R19E, S.L.B.&M. Basis of bearings is the west section line of the SW 1/4 of said section 22 which is assumed to bear S00.04'48"E.

7. Construction of the Project should be completed within six months after the start of construction.

Daggett County is seeking to obtain present possession of the property.
